

## Ian McDaniel, Executive Director, Virtual Care

As Executive Director of Virtual Care, Ian McDaniel uses technology to create more access to care for patients at Indiana University Health. In his role, he has launched the Behavioral Health Hub in 14 hospitals across the state of Indiana, giving patients in emergency rooms access to psychiatric evaluations and peer recovery coaching. Ian also led the development and launch of IU Health Virtual Visits, an on-demand service for low intensity visits that has provided one of the largest expansions of access for the IU Health system. In addition to overseeing the growth of Virtual Visits, he is also responsible for strategic development of IU Health's Virtual Care system strategy, including virtual complex care, virtual consults, second opinions and exploration into future applications.

Prior to joining IU Health, Ian worked for Corvel Corporation, serving as a Senior Vice President of Operations. During his time at Corvel, he led multiple national programs, including ancillary service scheduling, oversight, contracting, and durable medical equipment. He reported to the CEO and chairman of Corvel, assisting with strategy development for new service lines. During his tenure at Corvel, he maintained double digit growth in multiple service lines.

Before his role with Corvel, Ian held several positions in leadership with Physiotherapy Associates, including operations and direct patient treatment as a Physical Therapist.

Ian graduated from Indiana University with a degree in Physical Therapy prior to receiving his MBA from the University of Phoenix. He and his wife founded the Love More Foundation and return to Democratic Republic of Congo regularly to serve.

Ian has been married to his wonderful wife, Katie, for more than 20 years. They have eight children, five of whom are adopted. Ian and his family are active members at Northview Christian Church. In his free time, Ian is an avid runner and enjoys the outdoors with his family.
